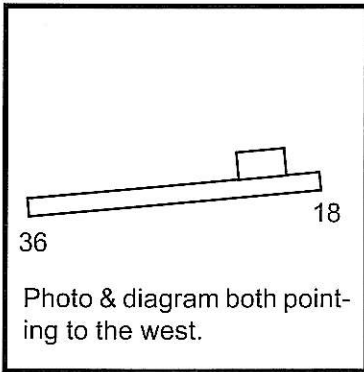
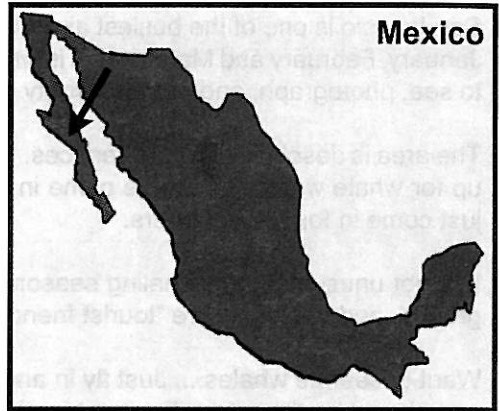

Normally, because of the wind, morning landing, departures are on 36 and afternoon landing, departures are on 18. Do not fly over water at low altitudes.

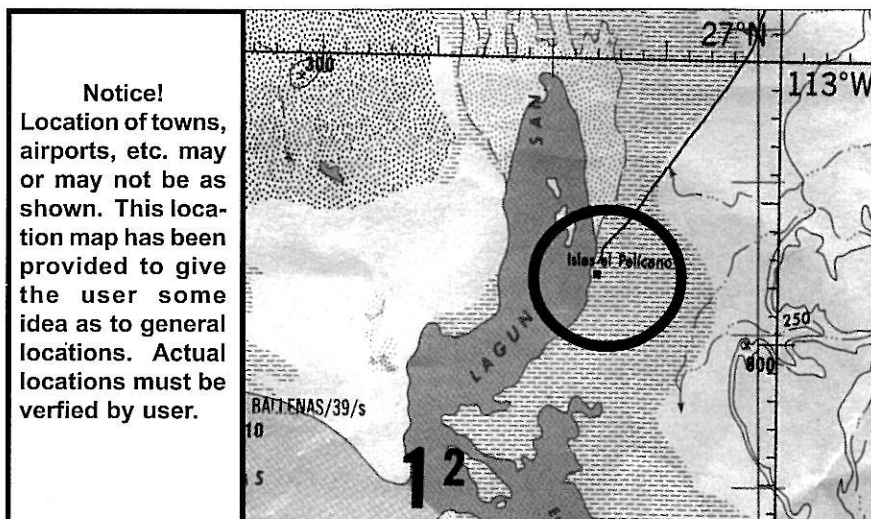
San Ignacio is one of the busiest airports in Baja during the months of January, February and March. This is where hundreds of tourists come to see, photograph, and pet the mighty gray whale.

The area is desolate with little services. There are several “camps” set up for whale watching. Some come in and spend a week and some just come in for several hours.

It is not unusual during whaling season to see 10 to 20 aircraft on the ground, and the locals are “tourist friendly”.
